The *Trains, Trolleys and Cars* itinerary will begin on **Thursday, November 4th**, with a catered cocktail party and dinner at the Radisson Lackawanna Station Hotel. Yes, it was the old train station in Scranton.

On **Friday, November 5**, Club members will visit Donald Bernstein's collection of cars housed at a warehouse at Maid Rite Steaks near Scranton. The collection contains over 30 cars including a Mercer, Cord and White. You'll see many Packards and Studebakers as well. Then we will travel to Antonioli's Restoration Shop which has mostly 20's and 30's vintage cars along with a collection of music boxes so large it fills an entire floor. Lunch will be at Ehrhardt's on Lake Wallenpaupack before heading to Milford, PA. We will then tour Grey Towers, the mansion of the Pinchot family and the role they played in conservation, and a private car collection at the home of David and Donna Helms. The day will conclude with dinner at the Hotel Fauchere.

Saturday, November 6, will takes us to John Walker's Collection. He has 19 Packards and several muscle cars housed in a new 6,000 sq. foot building. Then we travel to Minello's Classic Car Restoration Shop. Lunch will be at Agolina's Restaurant followed by a trip to Coventry Restoration Shop. The Harry Houdini Museum will entertain everyone before dinner at Fresno's where we will have a panoramic view Scranton.

In the morning on **Sunday, November 7**, you will get a hot beverage of your choice at the Hotel before walking over to Historic Steamtown and the Trolley Museum. For those who may not want to walk, there will be a shuttle service provided by the Hotel. You will be admitted to both Steamtown and the Trolley Museum as part of this tour. You may choose to take a Locomotive Cab Ride, a Trolley ride or just tour everything available.

The farewell luncheon will be back at the Radisson Lackawanna Hotel with time to talk about the experiences you had while being nourished by soup and sandwiches before departing for home.
