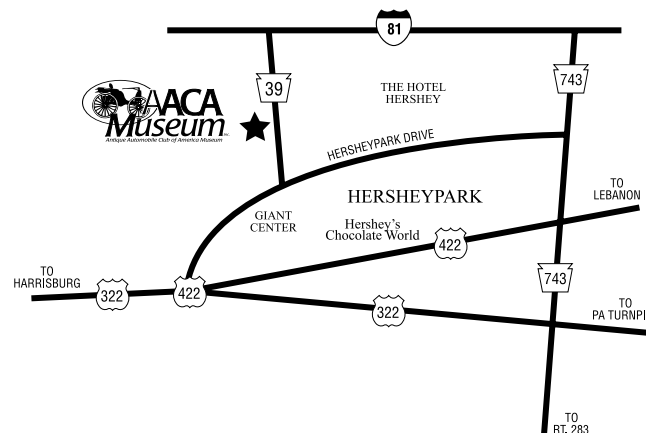

Groups of all types will enjoy this cross-country trip through the 20th century as they stroll unique scenes and settings from a working 1900's machine shop in New York's Battery Park to San Francisco's Golden Gate Bridge in the 1970's. Remember when gas was only 19 cents a gallon in our 1940's gas station or those hot summer nights in the 50's at the local drive-in. A walk through the galleries is a trip down memory lane. The museum is also home to the largest collection of antique buses on display under one roof in the United states.



Looking for the Limelight? Be sure to see the Lakeland bus used in the award winning movie "Forrest Gump". Or if spy movies are more your style, see several vehicles from the 1930's - 1950 used in the movie "The Good Shepherd".

The museum occupies three floors and over 70,000 sq. ft of exhibits to enjoy and is completely accessible for wheelchairs or strollers. We recommend that you allow 1-2 hours for touring the Museum including some time to browse the gift shop for specialty auto related items.
